2022 Fund-A-Need Aviation Award



Purpose

The Patriots Jet Team Foundation (PJTF), a 501 (c) 3 organization, located in Byron, California, is pleased to announce its **2022 PJTF Fund-A-Need Aviation Award Program** intended to further a student's aviation education. These scholarships are being made possible by the generosity of various donors who have a keen interest in supporting the PJTF aviation programs and activities.

The PJTF Aviation Award is designed to provide high school students with \$2,000 in funds for flight training on a fixed-wing aircraft (not a helicopter or glider) and on an account at a flight training facility selected by the PJTF to cover the cost of an instructor and/or plane rental. The funds will be distributed under the name of the PJTF Fund-A-Need Aviation Award Program.

The PJTF will make these awards as PJTF funds are available and reserves the right to select the applicants based on eligibility, contents of the application packets, and PJTF's evaluation process, which might include a personal interview. The recipients must complete their aviation training within <u>one</u> year of receiving notification of the award.

Eligibility

Applicants for the PJTF Aviation Award must meet the flowing criteria:

- 1) Applicants must be in high school and 15-18 years old.
- 2) Applicants must enroll or have completed 1) PJTF Introduction to Aviation Course, 2) a PJTF Aviation Advanced Studies course, <u>or</u> 3) non-PJTF equivalent course (PJTF will determined its equivalency).
- 3) Applicants must submit the Application Form (see page 2).
- 4) Applicants must submit two essays as described in the Application Form.
- 5) Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from an educator.
- 6) Applicants must submit the attached photo / video release form.

Application

All eligible applicants must complete and return an application packet by **December 28th** to be considered for a PJTF Aviation Award. Please submit your completed application packet via email (<u>dpaiva@mail.com</u>).

Selection Criteria

The PJTF will select the recipients based on the eligibility criteria, contents of the application packets, and PJTF's evaluation process, which might include a personal interview.

Payment of Award

The PJTF will determine the distribution process on how the funds will be awarded and the timeline for students to complete their related aviation education.
